<sup>1</sup> Standard Ithaca College tuition. 2024-25 rate will be announced in Spring 2024. Student's financial aid package will be applied in full to London Center costs, including Ithaca College scholarships & grants, New York State aid and federal aid. NOTE: RA stipends are not available to students in London. Work-study funds can be earned in London, but students must get student visa in order to do work-study.

<sup>2</sup> Program fee covers on-site orientation activities and welcome event, 1-2 day trips, health/well-being events throughout the semester, and pre-departure event.

<sup>3</sup> In addition to purchasing the required international health insurance, students who aren't covered under a parent's/guardian's domestic insurance must purchase the IC standard health insurance plan. Students must maintain domestic insurance since the international plan does will not cover them if they need to return to the US during the semester, or during the break between semesters. The per-semester cost of the IC standard health insurance plan is \$1,032.

<sup>4</sup> Students planning to only take classes, who will not intern or work in London, do not need to get a student visa, unless they are planning to remain in the U.K. for more than 6 months, or they are not citizens of either the U.S. or the U.K.

<sup>5</sup> Per-course ticket fees for classes requiring tickets to events range from \$100 to \$275. Total fees will depend upon how many ticket fee classes a student decides to take.

<sup>6</sup> Incidentals include limited independent travel, as well as other day-to-day living expenses. Students opting to travel extensively will likely spend more than the cost range provided here.

<sup>7</sup> Group air travel is offered as a convenience to students but is not required. Students are free to make their own airline ticket arrangements.
