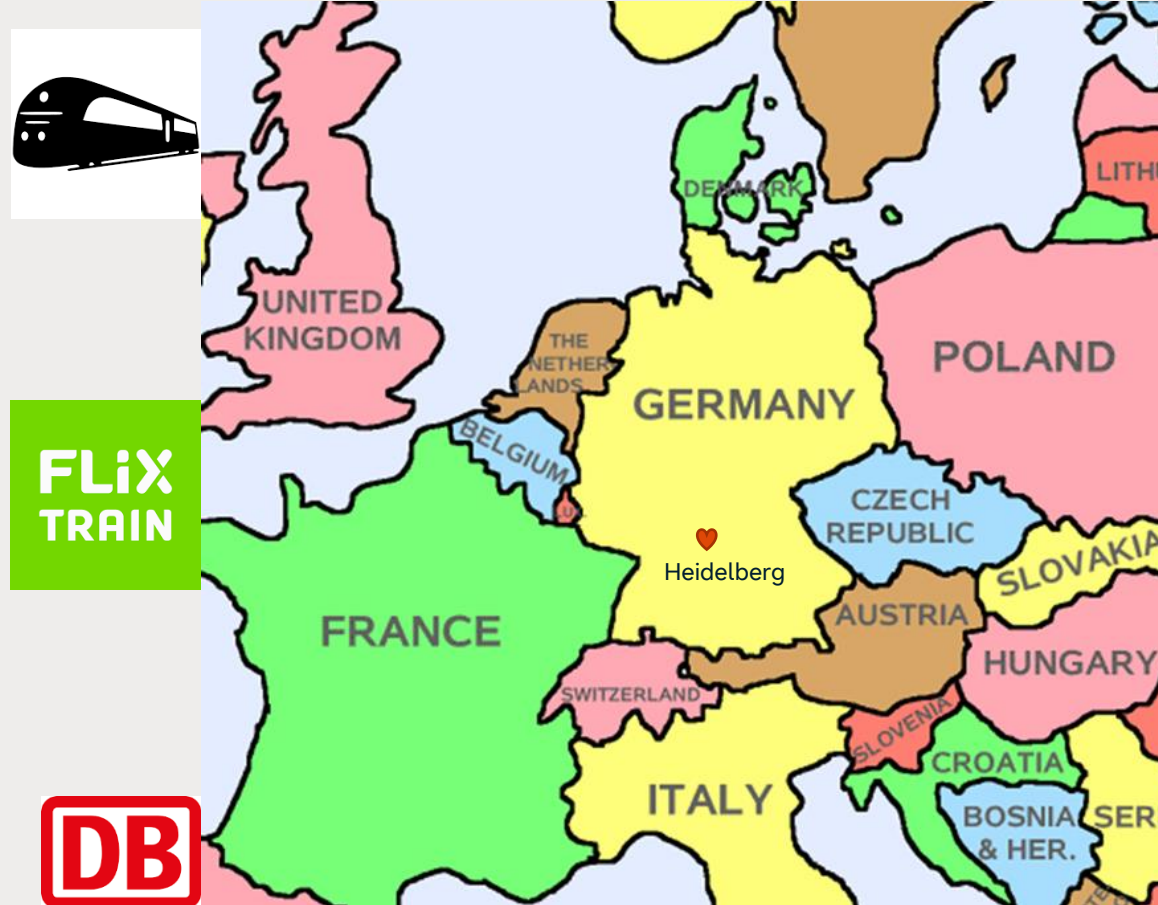

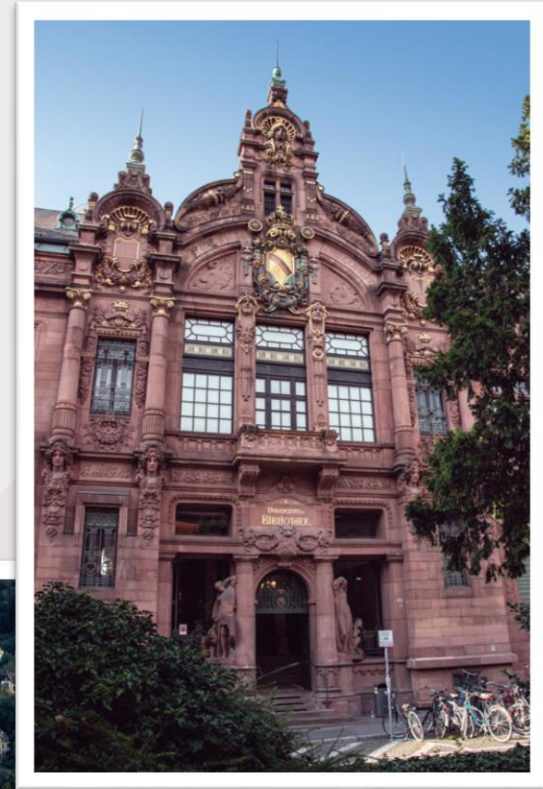

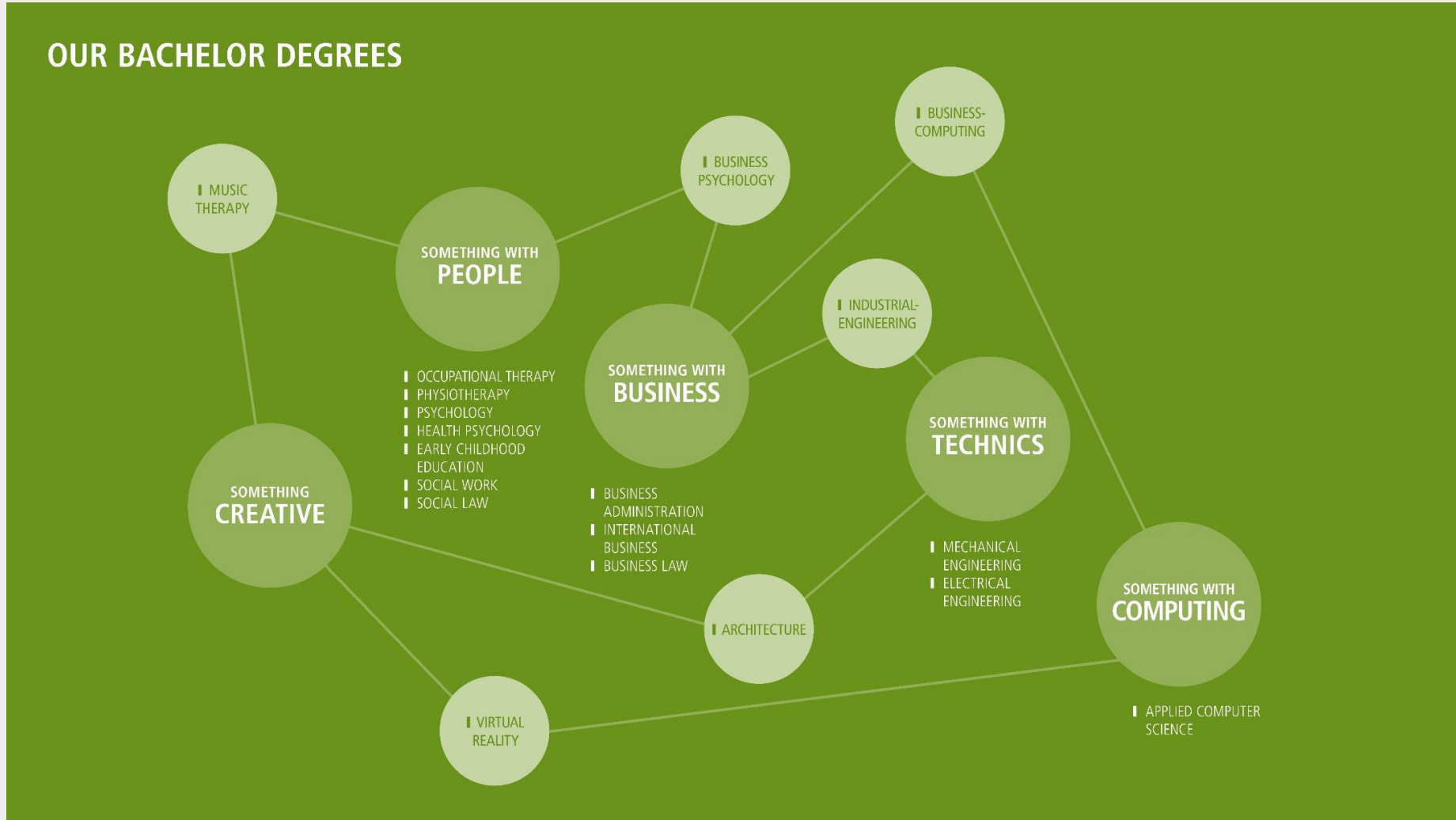

# Academics – School of Business

## — Course selection

The academic year at SRH University Heidelberg is divided into eight 5-week blocks.

In each block 8 ECTS, at the most, may be taken. Exams take place at the end of each 5-week block.

For each block you must choose ONE main course (highlighted in green). You can supplement the main course with one minor course not highlighted in green (white course). The number below each course represents the number of ECTS. You cannot achieve more than 8 ECTS / 4 US credits per 5-week block.

**Exception:** If you take an additional language course, e.g. German, you can achieve 9 ECTS per block. You can start at the beginning of any 5-week block of your choice, but you have to stay for a minimum of three consecutive blocks.
