Language of instruction:

English and German (not all courses are available in English)

Language Requirements:

Advanced English or German (min. level B2)

Course selection and exam method

The academic year at SRH is divided into eight 5-week blocks. In each block 8 CP may be taken. Exams take place at the end of each 5-week block.

Students can start at the beginning of any 5-week block in the year but have to stay for a **minimum of 3 blocks**.

The examination method at SRH Heidelberg is competence-based and is often a presentation, paper or a deliverable, in a team, as opposed to a formal written exam completed individually.

Arrival and orientation

There is always a **mandatory Orientation** session at/before the beginning of the courses. Students are expected to attend and have to arrive the day before at the latest.
