## IC SHORT-TERM (SUMMER/WINTER) STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMS Application process & next steps

- 1. You will first need to find and apply to your program of choice on the Ithaca College online application system, Terra Dotta, by finding your program at the following link:
  - bit.ly/IC-SA-program-search
- 2. Click on the active **program link**, and then click on the **Register/Apply** button. You will be asked if you would like to create an application; click **OK**.
- 3. You will then be asked to indicate how you will be logging in. Choose "I have a username and password", then log in using your Ithaca College Netpass username (e.g., bsmith) and password. NOTE: Do not use your full Ithaca College email address as your username.
- 4. Select the term you would like to go abroad and then click on the Apply Now button. This will bring you to your Program Application page. All of the pre-decision materials that Ithaca College requires will be displayed. Click on the active links and carefully read the instructions on how to complete these requirements. - 5. **You can access your application in Terra Dotta at any time** to continue working on required materials or to track progress by going to the main log in page: <a href="https://bit.ly/ICstudyabroad-login">bit.ly/ICstudyabroad-login</a>
- 6. Notification of acceptance to short-term programs is typically provided via email within approximately two weeks of the application deadline. Once you have received your acceptance to the program, be sure to get in touch with the faculty or staff member leading the program to find out whether there will be orientation meetings or events you will need to attend, or additional paperwork you will need to complete for visas or other entry requirements.
- 7. **Attend the mandatory orientation session.** *All students going on IC summer/winter programs must attend one orientation session.* The schedule of orientations for students planning to go abroad in either the Winter or Spring of 2024 is below. The orientation schedule for Summer and Fall 2024 will be available in late January 2024.

Meetings will be held synchronously via Zoom, and the recording will be posted in case you can't attend one of the synchronous sessions. Session recordings and additional orientation materials will be available to you on Canvas; you'll be invited to join the Canvas study abroad orientation site by mid-April for summer/fall and by mid-November for winter/spring.
