

Shopping suggestions from your PALs:

Items for your dorm or apartment:

Amazon/Ebay/etc. online sellers to purchase the items you need and have them shipped directly to you

Target and Walmart offer the same options

Groceries:

If you want to order groceries online and have them delivered to you: Wegmans, Walmart and target have that option. There are also specialty services like [Rosie](#) or [Instacart](#).

Food:

Most local restaurants have the option to order food online and have it delivered to you. Also check out restaurant delivery services such as [UberEats](#), [Grubhub](#) and [IthacaToGo](#).

Shopping:

Target, Wegmans, Tops and Walmart should have most things you will need. You can also order the items you need online and pick them up “curbside” from the store.

There is a **small convenience store on campus** called Mac’s, located in the [Campus Store](#).

Here are some umweltfreundlich (and very cost-effective) suggestions:

[TIOLI](#) -- an on-campus source for gently used dorm supplies

[Reuse](#) – two shops which resale useful items (furniture, clothes)

[Reuse Trail](#) – a directory of local second-hand sources is available. Some of those are on/near the Commons (the center of town).
