Shopping suggestions from your PALs:

Items for your dorm or apartment:

Amazon/Ebay/etc. online sellers to purchase the items you need and have them shipped directly to you

Target and Walmart offer the same options

Groceries:

If you want to order groceries online and have them delivered to you: Wegmans, Walmart and target have that option. There are also specialty services like <u>Rosie</u> or <u>Instacart</u>.

Food:

Most local restaurants have the option to order food online and have it delivered to you. Alco check out restaurant delivery services such as <u>UberEats</u>, <u>Grubhub</u> and <u>IthacaToGo</u>.

Shopping:

Target, Wegmans, Tops and Walmart should have most things you will need. You can also order the items you need online and pick them up "curbside" from the store.

There is a **small convenience store on campus** called Mac's, located in the Campus Store.

Here are some umweltfreundlich (and very cost-effective) suggestions:

TIOLI -- an on-campus source for gently used dorm supplies

Reuse – two shops which resale useful items (furniture, clothes)

Reuse Trail – a directory of local second-hand sources is available. Some of those are on/near the Commons (the center of town).

How to get places:

Uber, Lyft and taxi are always an option. Consider sharing the ride with a friend!
