## Ithaca is Artsy

**Films:** Attend a film at Cinemapolis (downtown) or Cornell Cinema, Regal Cinema at the mall

**Festivals:** Porchfest, Applefest, Chili Cook-Off (early this year they had a Nothing Nowhere had a special Mango Chili Donut that was phenomenal)

**Music:** Attend a concert put on by the IC Music School (see their website for a calendar), CFCU concert series, Cornell events

**Theater:** Attend a main stage or other performance in IC Dillingham, or at the Hangar Theatre

**Visual Arts:** Attend one of the gallery exhibitions at the Handwerker Gallery on campus or downtown

**Readings/Lectures:** Attend a lecture or a public reading on campus or in the Ithaca Community, the Ithaca Public Library hosts special events



## Ithaca Is Gorges

**State Parks:** Go to one of the 3 state parks in the area and have a picnic with your friends!

**Waterfalls:** Spend some time in the water or hiking by the water at more than 100 waterfalls. Try Taughannock Falls, Buttermilk Falls, and Ithaca Falls for a start!



## Ithaca Is Adventure

**Ford Observatory:** Go to one of the viewing nights at IC's Ford Observatory (first Friday of every month), or the Cornell Fuytes Observatory

**Food:** Go to the Farmers Market (open all semester!)

**Activities:** Ithaca Paintball, Ringwood Raceway Go Karting, Ice Skating (Cass Park, The Rink..)
